SB064 - NP300 NAVARA REAR SHOCK GUARD FITTING GUIDE

- 1. Remove the lower shock absorber bolt.
- 2. Remove the upper trailing arm bolt (be advised to only remove 1 upper trailing arm bolt at a time).

 See figure 1
- 3. Fit Shock Guard to vehicle, refit shock absorber in the OE location with the OE bolt.
- **4.** Refit the OE upper trailing arm bolt through the shock guard. See figure 1
- 5. Fit supplied M14 Bolt, washers & nut to the upper rear-most hole on the shock mount.

 See figure 2
- **6.** Fit supplied M12 bolt, washers and nut to the under-side of the shock mount. See Figure 3
- **7.** Repeat Step 1 to Step 6 on other side.
- 8. Tighten all bolts at road height.
- **9.** Cycle suspension travel to ensure there is no interference with other components on the vehicle.
